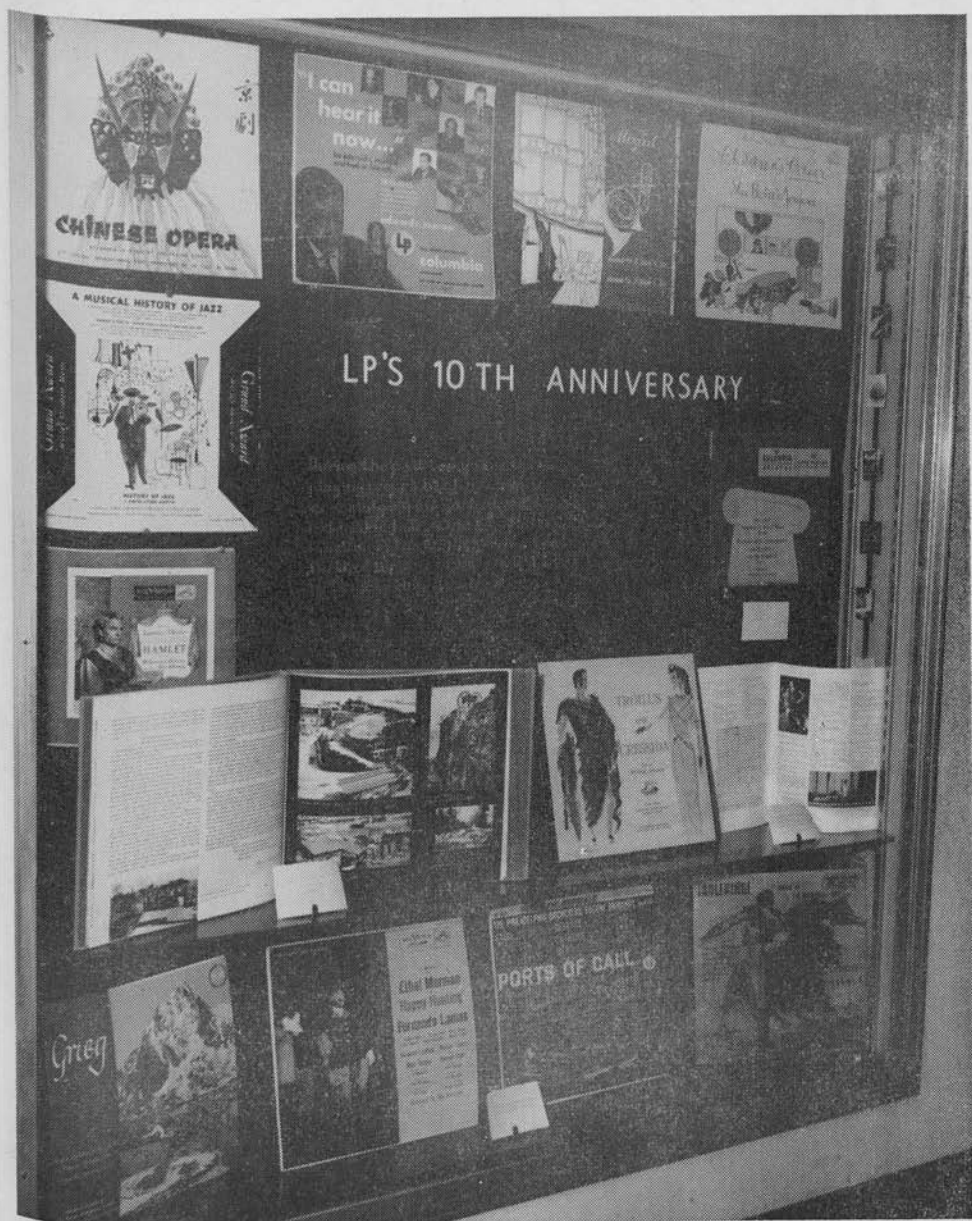


STUDENT EXHIBITS: THE SCHOOL OF LIBRARY SCIENCE
